

## **Gallivan Comments (Abbreviated)**

### Maintain an Active Year Round multi-purpose Gallivan Plaza

“Salt Lake City’s greatest urban amenities”, expand accommodations for winter time events

“Serves the public best by being a multi-use facility for all types and sizes of activities”

“more seating [is needed] where people can congregate –utilize the plaza not just when there is a special event.”

“Activate the plaza during the day/evening when there are not events taking place.”

“We need something that draws people in and keeps them coming back.”

“What we (Main Street business) consider most important for the Gallivan space is the programming. It keeps people downtown.”

### Make the Amphitheater Bigger/Modify the stage for more site lines

Need “Increased crowd capacity.”

“Accommodate larger capacities, remove the bridge.”

“Can the amphitheater be bigger?”

“Can you create a moveable stage – that has more view corridor.”

“Open up amphitheater seating- don’t constrict it.”

“Remove the bridge...creates huge bottlenecks...Why not expand stage... Extend the seating area for concerts.”

“I don’t come to the Gallivan often because it is often overly crowded.”

“I would like to see a Gallivan Center that allows more people to have a decent view of the stage.”

“The building helps to create a plaza feel”

“It looks perfect”

“This will add much more to the space than it occupies now.”

“I believe the new design is very attractive functional and serviceable.....I believe successful plazas need a sense of boundary and protection and your design does this beautifully.”

"Park zamboni and create skate rental east of stage."

"The building on 200 South is a mistake."

"The Gallivan needs more than a facelift. It needs to be reconsidered in a bold new way."

"I feel the rectangle building that is proposed would be just that, another building."

“This space has long felt disjointed.

“Should address street with bathrooms.”

“Are bathrooms this central to the design of the building and plaza.”

“Scrape the entire built area. Start Over.”
