

REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT PROFILE

CONGREGATION SPIRITS DISTILLERY



VISION

This project includes the adaptive reuse of a 12,000-square foot building for the development of a distillery, bar and grill, and working urban fruit orchard.

Congregation Spirits will be the first distillery in downtown Salt Lake City since the days of Prohibition. The project's outdoor space will include a dining patio and "spirit garden," and will feature a full-color mural by a local artist on the 140-foot wall on the south side of the space.

The distillery will be locally owned and operated, and the project's 32 manufacturing, kitchen, and serving jobs will be filled with the local work force. The project includes a bottle shop with a Type 5 Package Agency license from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control that provides the distillery a direct point of sale to the public.


